Father Roger Landry was designated one of three National Eucharistic Preachers for the Church's 3-year Eucharistic Revival which began in 2022. Ordained a priest of the Diocese of Fall River, Massachusetts, in 1999, he is an alumnus of Harvard College and the Pontifical North American College in Rome, where he did graduate work at the John Paul II Institute for Marriage and Family.
