The Catholic Healing Ministry of the Diocese of Arlington, Virginia will offer Mass and Healing Services throughout the year at various locations around the diocese. Reverend John H. Melmer will preside over these Masses. The next Healing Mass is on Tuesday March 28, 2023 at 7:30pm at All Saints Church in Manassas, Virginia. The full calendar of dates, times and locations is published below.

While it is true that every Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is a healing mass, it is particularly powerful when participants gather with the express desire to be healed. Following the Mass, the healing service begins with lay ministers praying over participants as live praise and worship music plays. A priest is available to hear confessions. Participants are welcomed to stand in proxy for someone who may not have been able to attend in person for a healing.
